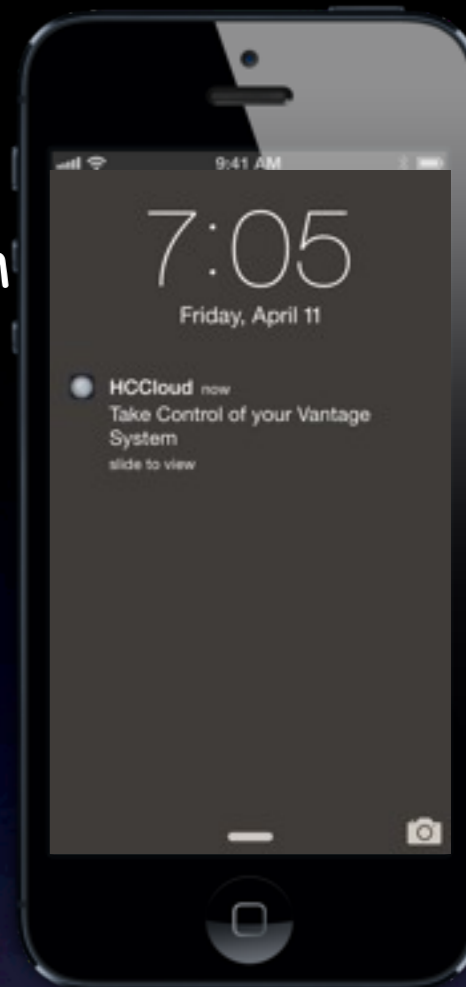


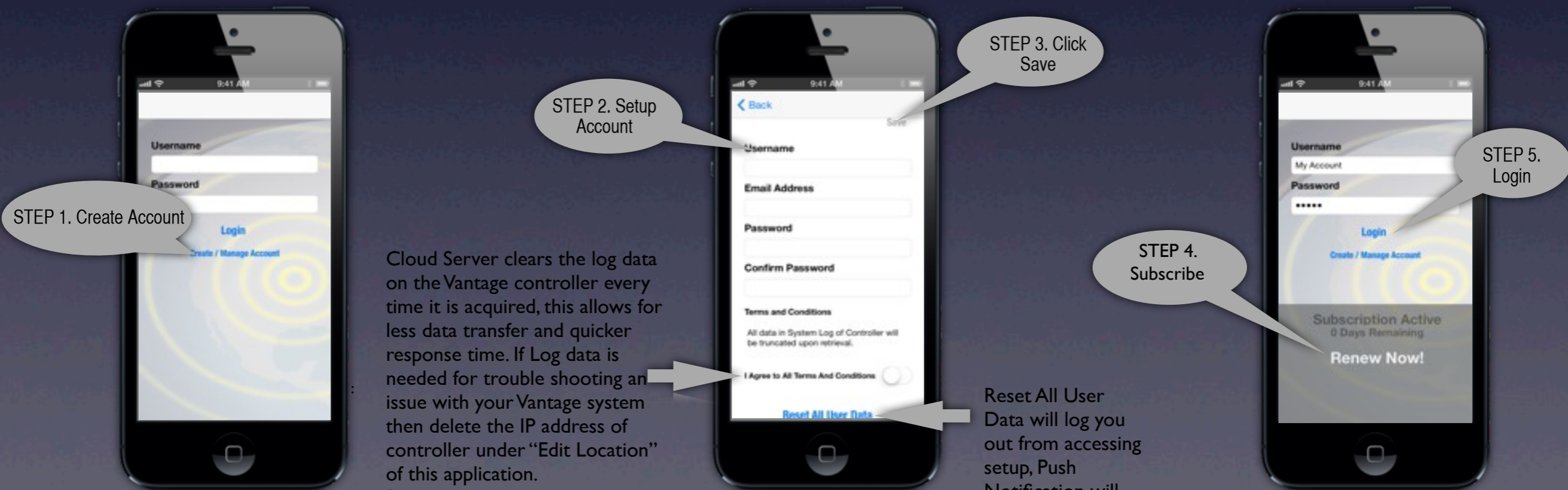
# Push Notification Cloud Services

## Providing Push Notifications from your Vantage Controls System to your Apple Devices, in 12 Simple Steps



- Yearly subscription from iTunes with unlimited devices (iPhone, iPad, and iPod Touch)
- Unlimited Push Notifications
- Services auto updates setup settings on all devices
- Standalone application or a great addition to Plus, Vantage and Equinox Applications

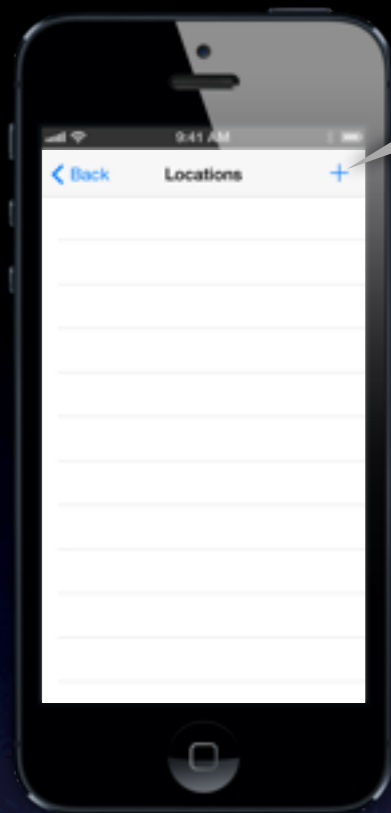
### Account and Subscription Setup



Cloud Server clears the log data on the Vantage controller every time it is acquired, this allows for less data transfer and quicker response time. If Log data is needed for trouble shooting an issue with your Vantage system then delete the IP address of controller under "Edit Location" of this application.  
 \*NOTE there is no on/off switch in app for communication to Cloud Server, it always remains

Reset All User Data will log you out from accessing setup, Push Notification will still be sent to device.

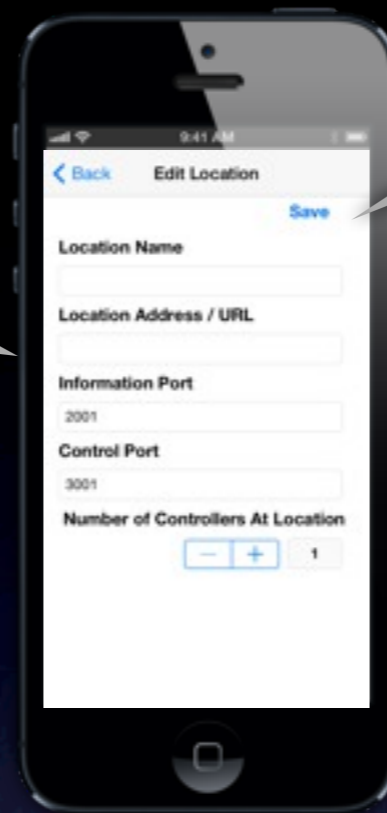
## Controller/Location Setup



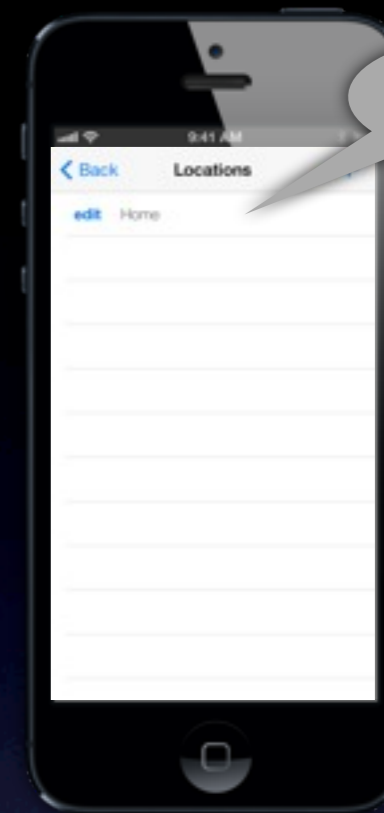
STEP 6. Add Location

NOTE: Requires Local Router to port forward ports 2001 & 3001 to LAN IP of Vantage Infusion Controller

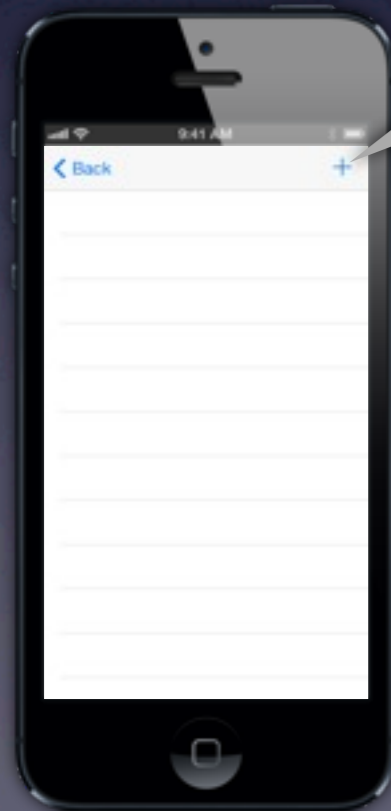


STEP 8. Click Save

## Notification Setup

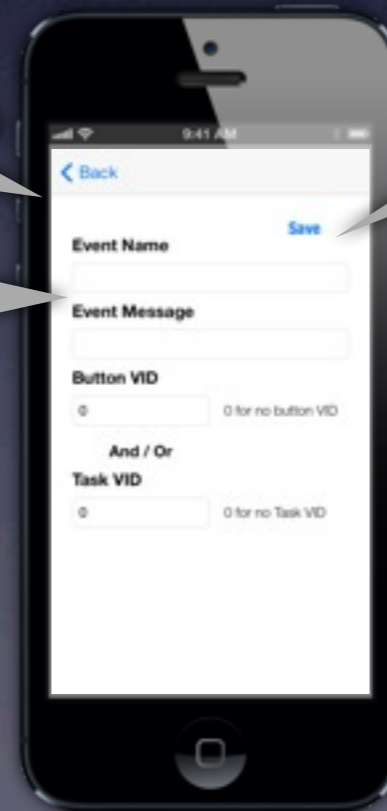


STEP 10. Add Notification

### General Info

- Buttons - Cloud Server sends notifications when a button is pressed and disregards the release
- Tasks - Cloud Server sends notifications when task is executed, there is no reporting based on task state
- All setup information is stored in the users Cloud Server account. Login to one device to update or setup all devices.
